

## E100 – Life Group Questions

(You'll need to be selective!)

### Week 14: The Cross of Christ

#### **1 Read John 19:17-24; Luke 23:33-34**

- What is significant about the sign Pilate prepared?
- How did Jesus pray for those who did this to Him? In asking for forgiveness, Jesus emphasised the meaning behind His own death. Talk about how His prayer illustrates the redemption and liberation made possible by the cross.
- What important lesson can we learn from Jesus about how we should pray for those who wrongfully treat us?

#### **2 Read John 19:28-30; Matthew 27:45-53; Mark 15:33-39; Luke 23:44-49**

- Compare how each of the gospel writers describes the death of Jesus. Discuss the importance of the Cross and what the death of Jesus Christ achieved.
- What is significant about the fact that the curtain in the temple is torn in two?

#### **3 Read Luke 24:1-12; Acts 1:1-3**

- What is the most convincing evidence for you of the resurrection of Jesus?
- What did Jesus do after the resurrection and what did He speak about? Why is this significant? Should this be a focus of our discussions and actions as Christians today?

#### **4 Acts 1:9-11**

- How do you think you would have felt watching Jesus ascend? Do you think Jesus will return to earth some day? How does that affect the way you live now?
